## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time (B), 12 July, 2009

Fr. John writes,

We are the Missionary Church. "Go, tell my people," is the command we have been given by God. And the message is the most stupendous one imaginable: that God has blessed us with all the spiritual blessings from heaven in Christ.

Today our missionary activities extend to the sea, when we pray for all seafarers who work away for months on end, separated from their families they love so dearly. Please remember the chaplains and ship visitors from the different Christian Traditions who do their best to care for them. Please remember those who work on the Lifeboats and by their skilful manoeuvres freely give their time to help those who travel on the sea when they get into difficulty and rescue is necessary.

Tomorrow, Monday 13th, is the Feast of Saint Mildred of Thanet – patron of the Isle of Thanet who founded Minster Abbey. Today, Sunday 12th, we begin to commemorate her feast with the whole of the Thanet Catholic Deanery by celebrating Holy Mass in the ancient, now Anglican, Parish Church of St. Mary the Virgin, Minster, at 3 pm.

Our Parish celebration of St. Mildred is tomorrow, Monday, with Mass at 5 pm, preceded by exposition.
